Notice of Desire to Continue Enrollment

It behooves the school and parent to be reminded periodically of the nature of their relationship. In order for a student's enrollment at Riverwood Classical School to continue into each succeeding school year, each of that student's parents or guardians must signify his or her desire to continue being assisted by Riverwood Classical School in the carrying out of his or her child's education by signing this form. We, the undersigned parents or guardians of the above-named students, upon prayer and due reflection hereby certify that:

1. We have reviewed the Educational Philosophy of RCS, which may be found in the Parent Student Handbook and at www.riverwoodclassical.org, support the same, and further desire that educational philosophy to govern the education of our student(s) at RCS.

2. We have reviewed the Statement of Faith of RCS, which may be found in the Parent Student Handbook and at www.riverwoodclassical.org, are in agreement with the same, and agree that our student(s) should be taught using the biblical doctrine described therein and which is more fully delineated in the Westminster Confession of Faith.

3. We have reviewed the Parent Student Handbook and agree to have our children conduct themselves and we agree to conduct ourselves, as regards all dealings pertaining to our children and RCS, according to the school's guidelines and procedures. In particular,

- (a) we agree to abide by the school's discipline policies and acknowledge that the ultimate responsibility for our children's behavior resides in us,
- (b) we agree to handle any disputes with or grievances against RCS, its teachers, or its staff in a manner consistent with biblical principles, such as those found in Matthew 18,
- (c) we agree to ensure that our student(s) dress in accordance with the school's dress code, and
- (d) we agree to pay our tuition and fees in a timely manner and, in the event that we do not pay in a timely manner, we agree to pay late fees as described in section 3.13 of the Parent Student Handbook.

4. The registration fee method that we plan to utilize with the submission of this notice is:

_____ \$50.00 per child being reenrolled paid at the time this notice is submitted, another \$50.00 per child paid the following month, and all remaining amounts paid the month after that.

_____ *Please initial:* I understand that the total due for the registration fee will increase if the registration fee has not been paid in full by June 30, preceding the school year for which this agreement is being made.

4. The tuition payment method that we plan to utilize during the upcoming school year is:

_____ Payment in full by August 1, receiving a 5% discount on the total.

_____ Payment in 10 equal monthly payments made by the first of each month beginning with August 1st.

_____ Payment in 12 equal monthly payments made by the first of each month beginning with August 1st.

_____ Payment by tuition assistance and 10 monthly payments of \$_____. (In order to select this option, there must be an executed Tuition Assistance Agreement for the school year to which this notice applies.)

_____ I/We are entitled to tuition remission resulting from teacher, staff member, or board member status.

Additionally, we understand that by signing this form we are contractually obligated to pay the full year's tuition or all monthly payments we have agreed to, as published, whether or not our student(s) return in August or attend the full school year at RCS. We further understand that we are not entitled to any refunds, discounts, or credits other than noted above.

5. We agree to pray for and promote the welfare, peace, and purity of RCS.

2011-2012 Fees and Tuition Rates

Tuition: Within each family, the tuition rates will be as follows:

First Child--\$4,800.00 per year (\$4,560.00 if paid by August 15)

or \$480.00 per month, if paid on the 10-month plan

or \$400.00 per month, if paid on the 12-month plan

Second Child--\$4,560.00 per year (\$4,332.00 if paid by August 15)

or \$456.00 per month, if paid on the 10-month plan

or \$380. per month, if paid on the 12-month plan

Third and Subsequent Children--\$4,400.00 per year (\$4,180.00 if paid by August 15)

or \$440.00 per month, if paid on the 10-month plan

or \$366.67 per month, if paid on the 12-month plan

Admission and Registration Fees: Within each family, the admission fee for new students and registration fee for returning students will be as follows:

First Child: \$250.00 (or \$300 if not paid in full by June 30)

Second and Subsequent Children: \$200.00 (or \$250 if not paid in full by June 30)

Consumables Fee: The school will charge each family the cost of those consumable supplies, such as workbooks, art supplies, etc, which are purchased for each student in the family. This charge is in addition to each family's responsibility to provide the supplies listed on each year's supply list for each child in attendance. Payment of the consumables fee will be due no later than September 30, 2011.

Late Fees:

For any tuition payment received after the 10th of the month: \$50

For any time that a child remains under the supervision of a staff member or teacher after 2:40 p.m. on a school day because a parent or caregiver has failed to pick the child up from school: the standard fee for after school care for that day
